Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund (SB

267): Requires funds in the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund to be paid as grants to the Rantoul Historical Society and Museum or any other charitable foundation responsible for the former exhibits and collections of the Chanute Air Museum.

Closed-Captioned Televisions (SB 309):

Requires facilities operating under certain hospital acts to provide closed-captioned televisions for persons with developmental disabilities in public waiting rooms and areas used for treatment.

Low-Speed Electric Bicycles (SB 396): Creates a three-tier system that defines low-speed electric bicycles based on motor capabilities. Removes low-speed electric bicycles from the section defining low-speed gas bicycles. Requires manufacturers and distributors to affix a label including classification, speed, and wattage information. Adds the regulation of low-speed electric bicycles and low-speed gas bicycles to the powers of local authorities.

State Vendor Payment Program Dentists (SB

634): Provides that CMS may establish a vendor payment program for dentists providing services to State of Illinois employees. Under this plan, qualified purchasers may purchase certain qualified accounts receivable owed by the State to participating vendors. The program shall be subject to any State offset of the purchase price for which any qualified account receivable purchased under the program equals 100% of the base invoice amount associated with such account receivable, as determined by the Comptroller. The purchase price for a qualified account receivable shall be determined by CMS. In consideration of the payment of the purchase price, a participating

dentist shall assign to the qualified purchaser all of its rights to payment of the account receivable.

Security Breaches, Computer Tampering (SB

707): Requires that any State agency that has been subject to a single breach or aggravated computer tampering to the security of its data to submit a comprehensive report to both the Attorney General and the General Assembly to disclose in specified ways any breach of the security of the system or data following discovery or notification of the security breach.

Compact Background Checks (SB 1085): Allows IDFPR to run background checks for current and future multistate medical compacts.

State Comptroller Act (SB 1094): Extends to July 1, 2023, a grandfather exemption for Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists for those licensed before Masters Degrees were required.

Forest Preserve Districts (SB 1493): Provides forest preserve districts can abate property taxes on certain property it acquires.

Railway Contract Carrier Coverage Verification (SB 1681): Provides that each rail carrier that contracts with a contract carrier for the transportation of its employees in the course of their employment shall verify that the contract carrier has hit-and-run, uninsured, and underinsured motor vehicle coverage in an

amount not less than \$500,000 per passenger.

Regulatory Rollback Legislation (SB 1821):

Repeals the Athlete Agents Act, the Detection of Deception Examiners Act, the Real Estate Timeshare Act of 1999, the Internet Auction Listing Service Section in the Auction License Act, and the Land Sales Registration Act of 1999.
