Human Services

Community Reinvestment Program (HB 399):

Ensures that individuals with a DON score of 29 or higher remain eligible for services until federal approval is received and on the basis that no more than 1% of recipients lose eligibility. Also, prohibits emergency rulemaking, and requires continued services for a year for anyone discontinued because of the new tool and requires reassessment 11 months after that determination, and sets eligibility guidelines for the Community Care Program (CCP) in statute (currently set by rule). As well as, requires service costs maximums to be set at a level no lower than the maximums that were in effect as of January 1, 2016 and increased accordingly to reflect any rate increases.

Clean-Up (HB 2713): Amends the Uniform Partnership Act ("UPA"), the Limited Liability Company Act ("LLCA") and the Business Corporation Act ("BCA") to clarify certain provisions and to correct various omissions. Such as removes Section 5 from the bill.
