



Senate Floor Reports

Bills that passed the Senate March 14, 2019

Tobacco 21 (HB 345): Raises the age to purchase tobacco, electronic cigarettes or alternative nicotine products to 21.

Dental Anesthesia for Autistic Patients (SB 111): Raises the age of an individual diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder receiving covered anesthetic services from 19 to 26. Specifies that a dentist or a physician can administer the anesthesia.

Hospital Assessment Fix (SB 526): Extends the sunset of requiring DCFS to reimburse free standing psychiatric hospitals the per diem rate beginning on the 11th day when the child is beyond medical necessity due to lockout from January 27, 2019 to July 1, 2020.
