



Senate Floor Reports

Bills that passed the Senate March 26, 2019

Child Abuse Reporting (SB 1239): Provides that any report received by DCFS alleging the abuse or neglect of a child by a person who is not the child's parent, a member of the child's immediate family, a person responsible for the child's welfare, an individual residing in the same home of the child or a partner of the child's parent is required to be immediately referred to the appropriate local enforcement agency and State's Attorney for consideration of criminal investigation or other action.

Dentist Credentials for Ambulatory Surgery Treatment Centers (SB 1291): Permits dentists to be credentialed at an ambulatory surgical treatment center in the event that their patient requires additional sedation and requires that the dentist performing surgery either have hospital admitting privileges or an agreement with a physician who does.

Healthy Pet Month (SB 1339): Designates April as "Healthy Pet Month" to encourage pet owners to review their pet's health needs and to make arrangements with their veterinarians for annual exams/evaluations.

Tax Exempt Property (SB 1456): Provides that certain leasehold property that is used for an airport, for parking, or for waste disposal or processing, and is used for a non-exempt purpose, is subject to taxation as a leasehold for the period of time during which it is used for that non-exempt purpose. Provides that the use of a portion of that property for a non-exempt purpose shall have no effect on the exemption of the remaining portion of the property that continues to be used for an exempt purpose or the future exemption of that same portion of the property if it ceases to be used for a non-

exempt purpose and returned to use for an exempt purpose.

Education Clean Up (SB 1461): Makes technical changes.

Agricultural Education Pre-Service Teacher Training Program (SB 1498): Creates a new Agricultural Education Pre-Service Teacher Training Program which is a 12-week internship program for qualified college students and Illinois agriculture companies. Under the program qualified college students can be paid up to \$7,500 for participating in the program. Subject to appropriation.

MWRD Salary Calculation for Benefits (SB 1582): Provides that the average final salary for MWRD employees is calculated by accumulating the salary for the highest 520 paid days of service within the last 10 years of service and dividing by 24.

Incarceration Credit Increase (SB 1609): Increases the credit for incarceration on a bailable offense from \$5 per day to \$30 per day.

Unclaimed Property (SB 1614): Allows an affidavit attesting to a person's ability to claim property and other documentation to be used to collect claims of less than \$100.

Post-Partum Depression Defense Law Fix (SB 1627): Relocates the provisions dealing with post-partum depression defense from the post-conviction act in the Code of Criminal Procedure to Section 2-1401 of the Code of Civil Procedure.
